Instrumental and vocal lessons

- These are held in the Music block.
- The timetables are located in the Music block corridor or Student Services.
- Check these on a weekly basis to find out the time and location of your lesson.
- Arrive five minutes prior to your lesson.

Frequently asked questions

What instrumental lessons are available at Ridgewood?

- We have a range of instrumental and vocal lessons: flute, clarinet, oboe, bassoon, recorder violin, viola, cello, double bass, trumpet, cornet, trombone, French horn, tuba, drums, electric and acoustic guitar, electric bass, singing, piano, keyboard. All lessons are provided by Doncaster Music Hub trained specialists.

How much do lessons cost?

- This depends on how long the lesson is. We heavily subsidise the lessons at Ridgewood and some lessons are free through our Opus programme. Currently an individual 15 minute lesson is £200.00 for the year, a 20 minute lesson is £260.00 for the year. Students can share lessons and this is £175.00 for the year.

When do instrumental lessons happen?

- Lessons happen during the school day. Your son/daughter simply needs to check their time on the Music notice board and then leave the curriculum lesson to attend their instrumental/vocal lesson. All lessons are held in the Music block.

How do I sign my child up to start an instrumental lesson?

- We will contact all primary schools in January to ask whether your son/daughter would like to learn to play an instrument or sing. Alternatively contact Miss Walker via the contact Us facility on our website.

What Music or Drama enrichment would be suitable for my son/daughter to join?

- Enrichment is open to all at Ridgewood. Take a look at our plethora of activities on the next page. We offer a range of enrichment activities that are free to go to every day. It might be 'Drama Limelights' which is a group for students interested in acting and developing teamwork and building confidence. It might be that your son/daughter loves to sing and wants to meet new people, in which case choir would be a suitable option. It may be that your son/daughter has a real interest in music tech/sound and lighting and therefore they can sign up to attend the tech group on Tuesday. *All enrichment runs from 3.00-4.00pm*
