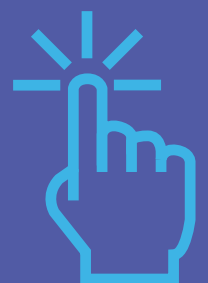

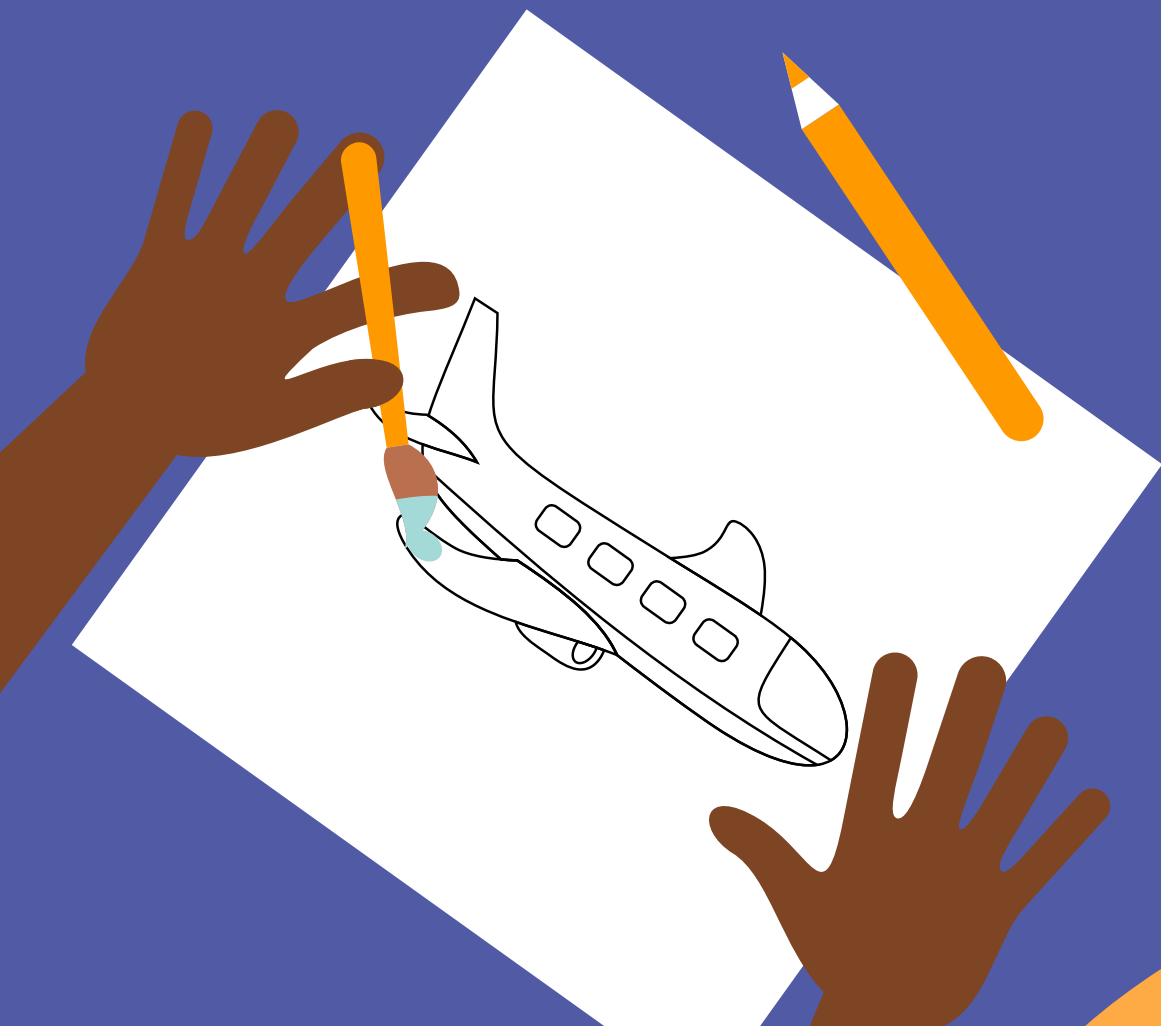
Our Year 10 Catering students got to have their plate decorating judged by Mrs Watson.

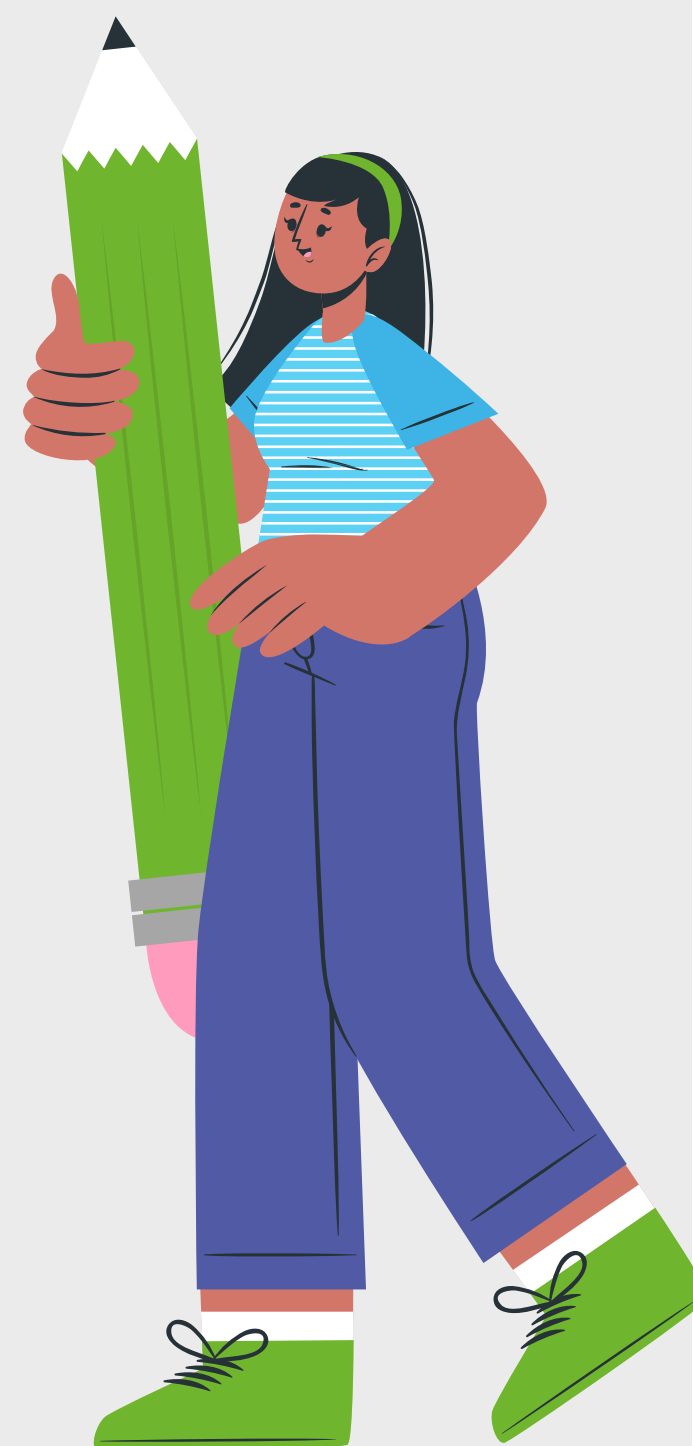
