Pre-Induction Task

For your Pre Induction Task, which is to be completed for your first Photography lesson in September, the Art team would like you to create a collection of images based on the alphabet.

You will be required to photograph all 26 letters of the alphabet. You are encouraged to photograph a minimum of three to five images per letter, a higher shooting ratio ensures the probability of getting the shot you want.

You may wish to present your finished project in a sketchbook, digitally or as a series of separate mounted images. Please ensure that the work is of a high standard and presented in a manner befitting of an A Level student.



The goal of the Alphabet Project is to locate and create images that represent each letter of the alphabet. This project is an opportunity for you to look deeper into the everyday and reflect on the world around you. You will choose how to express and combine graphic elements using the visual language of photography.

We advise you to take production notes to document your process, for example, camera used, lighting, time of day, etc and to also document any edits you make to your images as this is a practice you will use regularly within the course.
