Mocks and Exams- Expectations

All students will receive a timetable for their mocks and exams with clear rooms and seat numbers.

We ask our students to line up prior to the exams to help an easy entry Students need to enter the exam hall/room in silence

- Labels must be off water bottles.
- Pencil cases must be clear.
- Any paper in your pockets will need to be in your bag in the separate area.
- Mobiles will need to be off and in your bag.
- Students cannot bring any type of watch into the exam hall.
- No writing is allowed on their hand/arm.

If students are seen with these (even if you are not using them) it will <u>lead to disqualification</u> from the exam. Staff remind students at least three times before the exam begins of these rules.

Mocks and Exams- Reminder

You need to have the correct equipment for your exams, this will make you not only feel better prepared and less stressed but is often the key to gaining more marks.

You need to always have the following available:

- 2 black pens
- Pencil (and sharpener would be sensible!)
- Rubber
- Ruler
- Casio scientific calculator (no case)
- Compass
- Protractor







You must let your form tutor or teacher know if you are struggling to get the correct equipment a few days before the exams, we will help anyone who needs our support.



Resilience



- Check their revision timetable and hold them to account
- Remember helping them do their work is not the same as doing it for them
- Flash cards and self testing- take part by asking questions
- Deliberate practice- check your child is doing work by hand, writing working and writing their own notes rather than reading/highlighting
- Interleaving and spacing-check your child is revising in chunks across a range of subjects and topics
- Use the revision guide handed out tonight for further subject specific advice including websites and revision workbooks etc.
