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Dear parent/carer,

In order to maintain our high expectations within Physical Education lessons in the next academic year, please see below for a list of the PE kit that all students are expected to have:

**Indoor/Summer PE kit**

- Ridgewood PE t-shirt
- Navy blue loose fitting shorts
- Navy blue football socks
- Trainers (pumps, Vans or Converse are not permitted)
- Bare feet (for gymnastics)

**Winter Outdoor PE kit**

- Ridgewood PE t-shirt
- Navy blue thermal skin/under layers can be worn underneath the Ridgewood PE t-shirt
- Navy blue/sky blue reversible multi sports top
- Navy blue loose fitting shorts (navy blue skort can be purchased for hockey and netball lessons if preferred)
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms or thermal skin/under layers underneath shorts (optional)
- Navy blue football socks
- Trainers (pumps, Vans or Converse are not permitted)
- Moulded football boots (compulsory for football and rugby – metal studs are not permitted)
- Shin pads (compulsory for hockey and football)
- Scrum caps/mouth guards for rugby and hockey (optional)

**Hair**

- All students should have long hair tied up - if their hair is too short to tie up but obstructs their face, they should bring a headband and/or hair grips.

**Students with injuries/illness**

All students are expected to bring and wear the correct PE kit and take part in as much of the lesson as they can. This includes students who are injured, unwell etc. However, students who are unwell may be given less strenuous activities to complete throughout the lesson.

If a student is required to opt out of the practical aspect of the lesson, they must provide a doctor's note – the correct PE kit must still be brought in regardless, unless this has been discussed with and agreed by their teacher.
