Well done to all the players!




















Badminton




Careers Fair

Ridgewood students did the school proud!












STEM Session


On Friday 2 February, University of Leeds Postgraduates delivered a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) session to our Y10 Engineering students.


The session was based on 'Designing a Sustainable Music Festival'. Students were tremendously engaged and were able to think about how engineering is used in different ways.
















Tate Modern
